# Chief's Report:

There were 22 alarms in January with 22 alarms YTD.

The LOSAP points were posted on 1/1/24 and taken down on 2/11/24.

A quote for 8 sets of firefighter gear was received in the amount of \$31,256, boots for \$450/pair, fabric gloves \$80.95 each and leather gloves \$71.82 each.

M. Westbrook's phone was ordered on A. Cote's credit card and T-Mobile will credit our account for the amount of \$429.99.

The turbo on 51-5 is acting up again. The cost to replace it with a rebuilt is \$791 plus labor and \$1,244 plus labor to purchase a new one.

A. Cote contacted Logical Net for destroying our old PC's, it takes about 15-20 minutes per PC to remove the data and this would be charged against our managed hours. When completed, we will receive a certificate of destruction to keep on file.

Adirondack Overhead Doors cannot get parts for our door remotes as they are obsolete. They recommended upgrading to Lift Master receivers, the cost to replace our 6 door remotes, including labor, would be \$1,535.

Alarm & Suppression conducted the extinguisher inspection and many failed. The cost to replace the extinguishers is approximately \$1,927.

Old firefighter gear is being surplused. A. Cote is working with NYS Fire Chief's Assoc. to see if the gear can be donated to Firefighters Across the Borders.

A. Cote met with Kenwood and Motorola to get quotes needed to apply for the Volunteer Firefighter and AFG grants. The cost for an NFPA approved Motorola radio is \$7,900 per radio. Susan Westbrook is assisting in the writing of the Grant.

Previously ordered firefighter gear has arrived and been put in service.

Items to be surplused are:

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Approval was unanimously given to surplus the radio room PC and the ID card printer on a motion by P. Van Schaick/L. Gates.

The purchase of 8 sets of firefighter gear was discussed. It will take approximately 20 weeks until it arrives. A vote was taken as follows to purchase the gear. L. Gates yes, P. Krawiecki yes, M. Trombley yes, P. Van Schaick yes, R. Cote yes. Motion is unanimously approved,

M. Westbrook stated that she was questioned by exterior firefighter if they should have a second set of gear.

Unanimous approval was given on a motion by L. Gates/M. Trombley to purchase exterior gear for Firefighter Bennett.

Unanimous approval was given on a motion by L. Gates/P. Van Schaick to purchase a new turbo for 51-5 for the approximate cost of \$1,244 plus labor.

Thirteen firefighters earned LOSAP points for 2023.

P. Van Schaick made a motion to move \$1,500 from the general fund to recruit and retention line of the budget. Approval was given on a motion by P. Van Schaick/M. Trombley. R. Cote abstained.
