Chief's Report:

There were 9 alarms for March with 32 alarms YTD.

The recall for 51-0 has been completed.

The 51-2 fuel recall has been corrected.

A. Cote requested a magnet to cover M51-4 now called M51-6. L. Gates suggested new graphics.

Alec Cameron and Cef Miranda have completed BEFO and are now in IFO training.

A Cote researched the previously discussed purchase of helmets. Bullard helmets from Dival are \$325 each for 10 or more and would include 1 free helmet. Approval was given on a motion by L. Gates/P. Van Schaick for a cost not to exceed \$3,900.

Approval was given on a motion by L. Gates/W. Schoenborn for new graphics on M51-6.

Dick Tulloch has been a member of the fire company since 4/6/72. The company will be celebrating his 50th anniversary at Tuesday's company meeting.

Board Member Reports:

W. Schoenborn:

W. Schoenborn stated that P. Van Schaick is on the agenda for approval by the town board as chairman of the Emergency Services Advisory Board replacing Al Atwell.

M. Trombley:

M. Trombley is working on putting together an MSDS book for the district.

P. Van Schaick:

Steve Sawn will be sending two quotes for our insurance, McNeal and another to be determined. Our insurance renews on June 1st.

P. Van Schaick spoke with Tony Hill at Firefly concerning points earned during military deployment. Firefighters need 1 year of earned points before they qualify for earned points during military deployment.

R. Cote:

- R. Cote submitted \$750 for community room rentals to be deposited to the general fund savings account.
- R. Cote investigated having a service strip and wax the floors. This service also offers a maintenance schedule after the floors are waxed. The cost for stripping and waxing the floors is

\$1,910. Approval was given on a motion R. Cote/W. Schoenborn to have the floors stripped and waxed for a cost not to exceed \$1,910. The maintenance schedule will be discussed at another meeting.

Three of the four outside pole light do not work and need new sockets. R. Cote arranged for them to be repaired this week.

Grastorf will be submitting a price increase for our lawncare service for approval.

The back door has been fixed.

L. Van Schaick:

Nothing to report.

L. Gates:

L. Gates discussed the possibility of purchasing a new conference room table with our logo in the middle. He will investigate the cost. He also suggested replacing the carpet with laminate wood floors. R. Cote will get prices for carpet and laminate flooring.

L. Gates left a message for Jonathan at Tedisco's office concerning the check for our approved grant. He has not received the requested call back.
