The SCBA battery change will be done next week, and the Compressor maintenance will be completed in 2026.

Clifton Park-Halfmoon FD gave us 6 new SCBA bottles to replace the ones they lost.

Some members need to complete the OSHA Sexual Harassment training by 12/31/25. There are social members and auxiliary members that did not attend the mandatory training offered on December 2nd. A discussion followed as to what to do for those members who are not in compliance.

The truck repairs have been completed.

The Santa drive around the district will be on Saturday, December 13th from 10 -1.

Since Motorola has extended their discount on radios to 12/31/25, A. Cote would like to purchase 5 new radios for an approximate cost of \$43,000.
